LOT 19 - Gun 'A' barrel: 19 inch round.

LOT 90 - Estimate: 1000 - 1600.

LOT 94 - Headline: **Antique Winchester Model 1873 Lever Action Rifle.**

LOT 99 - Caliber: 40-85.

LOT 100 - Rifle is pictured and identified in the 2002 edition of G. Scott Jamieson's "Bullard Firearms" on pages 182 and 183 where it is listed as being rebore to 22 K-Hornet. However, the rifle is now in original .32-40 Win. caliber, as identified by the original caliber stamp on the top of the frame. Classified as antique.

LOT 200 - Appears to operate on the Beringer pattern in-line fulminate ignition system.

LOT 207 - Gun 'A': A "puzzle gun" with no visible screws and a hidden mechanism in the grip lanyard ring that allows it to move forward to remove the grips and a complete disassembly without tools.

LOT 235 - Gun 'B' Headline: **Rare Francotte 10-Shot Revolver.** Grips: Ebony.

LOT 256 - Custom carved grip. Rating should read: OF NPRF.

LOT 335 - Rating: OE WB.

LOT 417 - Gun 'F' rating: OB NPRF WW.

LOT 441 - Gun 'A' Rating: OC.

LOT 451 - Rating: OE.

LOT 469 - Manufactured in 1886.

LOT 507 - Gun 'A' rating: NC PRF WW. Gun 'B' rating: NC PRF WW.

LOT 571 - Gun 'B' caliber: 7.62 x 45 CZ. Gun 'C' Caliber: 7.62 x 45 CZ.

LOT 553 - Caliber should read: 8mm

LOT 555 - Headline should read: **DWM Model 1906 Royal Portuguese Navy Contract Style Luger.** This is a Model 1906 modified to a rare Royal Portuguese Navy contract variation.

LOT 641 - Caliber should read: 8mm

LOT 698 - Gun 'A' headline: **Japanese Type 30 Arisaka Training Rifle.** Caliber: 6.5mm Japanese Blank

LOT 706 - Gun 'C' Falls into the wartime Bulgarian contract, 3rd delivery, 3-23-44.

LOT 708 - Gun 'B' - White Star Line owned a fleet of ships, including the Titanic, and had pistols redone in nickel for better protection against the salty environment.

LOT 709 - Gun 'A' headline should read: **German Marked CZ Model 24 Pistol.**

LOT 778 - Headline: **World War I U.S. Colt Model 1911 Semi-Automatic Pistol with Rare Commercial/Military Slide and Factory Letter.**

LOT 819 - Manufactured in 1916.

LOT 914 - Headline should read: **Smith & Wesson Pre-Model 21 .44 Hand Ejector Model of 1950 Military Double Action Revolver.**

LOT 947 - Rating: OE.

LOT 989 - Headline should read: **Two Colt Woodsman Semi-Automatic Pistols.**

LOT 1007 - Caliber: 45 ACP.

LOT 1044 - Sticker on pistol grip indicating the gun has a "release trigger"

LOT 2670 - Headline: **Scarce Egyptian "Eagle Of Saladin" Fabrique Nationale Model 1949 Semi-Automatic Rifle.** Only 1,500 FN 49 receivers with "Eagle of Saladin" crest and "Egyptian Army" in Arabic inscribed under the Eagle were produced. They were manufactured at the end of the normal FN 49 production before FN shut down the production line.

Chamberlin" on the left side of the receiver; the consignor attributes this signature to Colonel Frank Chamberlin, military trauma surgeon, ballistics expert, and early proponent of the "hydrostatic shock" model of gunshot trauma. Fitted with a 14 inch non-functional barrel, cut-down stock and a leather sling. Includes a cutaway cartridge. Caliber should read: 8x x57 cal. Rating should read: OE.

LOT 4527 - Gun 'C' - Falls into the wartime Bulgarian contract, 3rd delivery, 3-23-44.

LOT 4530 - Gun 'B' headline should read: **French E. Lefauchaux Brevet Model 1854 Single Action Revolver**. Falls into the serial number range of a Civil War Union contract (25000-35000).

LOT 4567 - Gun E caliber : 8mm.

LOT 4588 - Headline should read: **DWM Model 1906 Royal Portuguese Navy Contract Style Luger**. This is a Model 1906 modified to a rare Royal Portuguese Navy contract.
