CORRECTIONS

LOT 2 - This rifle is the first deluxe Model 1894 manufactured by Winchester and has the first style receiver.

LOT 91 - Headline: **Three Savage Model 1899 Lever Action Long Guns.**

Gun C headline: **Savage Model 1899 Barrel Band Carbine.**

LOT 97 - Headline: **Maynard Improved Target No. 15 Rifle.** With chamber cast. Caliber: 22-10-45

LOT 98 - Estimate: 5000 - 7000.

LOT 157 - Caliber: 38 RF.

LOT 200 - Fragile, torn in places.

LOT 229 - Gun A Headline: **Colt New Line 41 Revolver with Scarce 4 Inch Long Barrel with Factory Letter.** Factory letter lists revolver as chambered in .41 CF with blue finish (barrel length and type of stocks not listed) when shipped to Hodgkins & Haigh, New York City, on November 16, 1877.

LOT 293 - Signed "R. Wetnight" (Richard H. Wetnight), with a lead tag hanging from the trigger guard stamped "14"; Wetnight reached out to us after going to press to state that this is the manufacture date for the rifle.

LOT 381 - Estimate: 6000 - 9000.

LOT 395 - Gun A gauge: 12 gauge.

LOT 423 - Headline: **Smith & Wesson No. 3 American First Model Single Action Revolver.** Manufactured 1870-72.

LOT 435 - Headline: **Two Sheffield Style Bowie Knives with Sheaths.** Artificially aged blades and fittings.

LOT 474 - Headline: **Scarce and Exceptional Post-World War II Hungarian Model 91/30 M52 Bolt Action Sniper Rifle with Bayonet.** Includes "1954" dated scope (optics clear), leather lens covers and bayonet.

LOT 490 - Gun A: Includes two extra magazines and a leather single magazine pouch.

LOT 529 - Gun C Caliber: 45 ACP.

LOT 531 - Headline: **Two Military Semi-Automatic Handguns with Holsters.**

LOT 585 - Gun A Headline: **Russian TT-33 Pistol with Holster.** With an extra magazine and brown leather holster.

LOT 607 - Gun C barrel length: 29 1/2".

LOT 619 - Gun B caliber: 8x56 mm.

LOT 632 - Gun B caliber: 9mm.

LOT 684 - Headline: Browning Model 1917 Tripod. Identification plate marked "1917A1", "209421", "McEVOY" maker marked and "1943" dated.

LOT 706 - Comes with a March 1940 dated Honolulu, Territory of Hawaii firearms registration for this pistol. Pistol registered to Leo G.D. McDermott, U.S.S. Sunnadin (AT-28).

LOT 763 - Gun B includes 2 magazines.

LOT 802 - Caliber: 45. "45 AR" marked on barrel.

LOT 994 - Has a Geissele Super Scar trigger and OSS flash hider.

LOT 979 - A special edition rifle that is a clone of the rifle issued to the British army and includes a Geissele trigger and Knights Armament flash hider.

LOT 989 - Rifle built for the consignor by Morris Custom Pistols of Oroville, WA and includes a carbon fiber barrel and custom trigger.

LOT 2015 - Headline: **Rare Special Order Winchester Semi-Deluxe Extra Lightweight Model 1894 Lever Action Takedown Rifle.** Model 1984s featuring a lightweight octagon barrel in .38-55 are rarely encountered.

LOT 2079 - Per consignor these drawings came from the William Mason family. William Mason was a renowned gunsmith who worked for Remington, Colt and Winchester. Mason is perhaps best known for his patent designs used on Colt's Richards-Mason conversion revolvers. He left Colt in 1882 to work for Winchester where he designed a revolver known as the Centennial revolver to compete with Colt handguns. As legend has it, Winchester and Colt executives

reached a "gentleman's agreement" for Colt to quit making rifles and for Winchester to never enter the revolver market. The Centennial revolver was never mass produced.

LOT 2098 - Caliber: 49-90.- Case length marking appears to be 2 1/10 but will chamber 2 4/10 (45-90). Estimate: 5000 - 7000.

LOT 2126 - Gun A caliber: 38 RF.

LOT 2477 - Rating: OF WB Broken firing pin.

LOT 2523 - Gun D caliber: 308.

LOT 2577 - Gun A Rating: ND NPRF.

LOT 2638 - With extra barrel (per consignor chambered in .308).

LOT 2901 - Per consignor rifle was built by American Hunting Rifles of Corvallis, MT.

LOT 2922 - Headline: **High Standard 10-X ML Series Semi-Automatic Target Pistol with Box.**

LOT 2957 - Gun A: Manufactured 1931-1949. 2 3/4" chamber, full choke, and 14 1/2" LOP.

LOT 2961 - Per consignor shotgun was customized by Cole Gunsmithing including trigger and removal of center bead to help facilitate aiming.

LOT 2987 - Per consignor this is a custom rifle from Longrifles, Inc. Barrel is threaded for a suppressor.

LOT 3002 - Caliber: 44 special.

LOT 4227 - Headline: **Two Colt Pocket Handguns.**

LOT 4236 - Headline: **Four Pepperbox Pistols.**

LOT 4270 - Gun A: With a copy of "J. P. Clabrough: Birmingham Gunmaker" signed by the author Lawrence P. Shelton.
