LOT 2047 - Headline: **Custom Engraved Gold and Nickel Plated Winchester Model 1876 Lever Action Rifle with Special Order Style Sights and Factory Letter.** The included factory letter states the rifle was received in the warehouse on August 29, 1892 and shipped September 7, 1892 with an octagon barrel in .45-70 caliber, nickel finish, set trigger, seven leaf and beach sights, sling, and swivels.

LOT 2210 - Provenance: The George Moller Collection; Property of a Gentleman. Estimate: 2500 - 3750.

LOT 2252 - 1) Wells Fargo Style Model 1849 two cavity iron bullet mould. Listed as an experimental in Rapley's "The History and Identification of Colt Accoutrements 1834-1911: Paterson to Automatic," M18. Good with scattered handling marks and an attractive grey patina. Formerly of the Senator Charles Ford collection. 2) Colt Thunderer .41 caliber bullet mould. Fine with storage and handling marks, some pitting, and a dark patina overall. 3) Colt Lightning .38 caliber bullet mould. Fine with storage and handling marks, some pitting, and a dark patina overall. Bullet moulds 2 and 3 are pictured in Rapley's "The History and Identification of Colt Accoutrements 1834-1911: Paterson to Automatic" on page 146 and are formerly of the Senator Charles Ford collection. 4) Colt Model 1851 Navy two cavity bullet mould in the pre-1860 pattern (2nd Model) with "W" inspector stamp on the right block. See Rapley's "The History and Identification of Colt Accoutrements 1834-1911: Paterson to Automatic," M22. Excellent with a bright coloration and slight patina.

LOT 2633 - Gun A Headline: **U.S. Springfield Armory Model 1903 Rifle.**

LOT 2846 -Antique. Manufactured in 1893.

LOT 3073 - Lower receiver marked "MODEL VRS/CAL.223", unmarked attached upper receiver and barrel assembly chambered in .50 BMG. Includes bipod and parts. With 20x42 scope. Per consignor the upper receiver is by Advanced Long-Range Systems and the trigger by Jard.

LOT 4109 - Manufactured c. 1871 - 1881.

LOT 4541 - A unique feature on these scopes was the illuminated reticle. When light shined through a glass window on the right side of the scope, the reticle turned from black to a silvery white. The scope used a Redfield 1903A4 base (not included). An estimated 500 were manufactured.

LOT 4628 - Gun C rating: NB PRF.

LOT 4651 - Manufactured in 1915. Part of the "1,000 additional pistols, consecutively serial numbered in Colt's regular serial range from C20001 to C21000, also marked with Argentine numbers from 1 to 1000 on top of the slide" purchased by the Argentina government in 1915 (see Clawson's "Colt .45 Service Pistols," page 157). Top of slide is marked with the number "576."

LOT 4661 - Headline: **E. Schmidt & Haberman Short Action (Kurz) Model 21 Bolt Action Rifle with Scope.**
