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LOT 76 - **Caspian Arms 1911A1 Semi-Automatic Pistol with Colt Super .38 Slide** - Serial no. 31398, 38 super cal., 5 inch round bbl., blue finish, walnut grips. Barrel marked "COLT SUPER .38 AUTO/MK. IV SERIES '70".

LOT 120 - Consignor states rifle is new in box.

LOT 121 - Consignor states rifle is new in box.

LOT 124 - Barrel is marked "MADE IN THE 200TH YEAR OF AMERICAN LIBERTY". Consignor states rifle is new in box.

LOT 194 - With four additional choke tubes (full, modified, improved cylinder, and skeet) and choke tool. LOP: 14 1/4", 3" chamber, choke tube system (improved modified installed).

LOT 197 - Extra barrel is 24 inches.

LOT 205 - With two additional choke tubes (1/4 and and Skeet) and choke tool. LOP: 14 3/8", 2 3/4" chambers, choke tube system (1/2 and 3/4 installed).

LOT 238 - Headline should read: **British Style Percussion Conversion Musket**. Features a British style burst pattern on the barrel and an acorn style finial. Both the lock marking and an inscription on the butt plate are mostly illegible. Ramrod absent.

LOT 258 - Gun 'A' condition rating should read: NC NPRF. Manufactured circa 1940-1941.
Gun 'B' serial number should read: J1847. Manufactured circa 1952.

LOT 287 - Includes a group of assorted .22 caliber ammunition. Some boxes may be either partial or empty. Some manufacturers include: Winchester, Western, Remington, and Federal. The case is cracked near the upper hinge screw. Measures 13" tall, 12" across, and 6" deep.

LOT 389 - Gun 'B' Rating should read: OG NPRF. Classified as antique. Barrel has been cut down and firing pin is broken.

LOT 419 - Features a saw cut and welded gas cylinder.

LOT 441 - Manufactured by DC Industries. Russian trunnion dated "1965".

LOT 458 - NOTE: This lot cannot be shipped to CA, CO, CT, D.C., MD, MA, NJ, NY, VT due to magazine capacity restrictions.

LOT 562 - Gun 'B' Rating should read: NE WW.

LOT 571 - Gun 'A' headline should read: **Belgian "British Constabulary" Revolver**
Condition rating should read: OE NPRF WW.

LOT 616 - Barrel is marked "MADE IN THE 200TH YEAR OF AMERICAN LIBERTY". Consignor states rifle is new in box.

LOT 619 - Barrel is marked "MADE IN THE 200TH YEAR OF AMERICAN LIBERTY". Consignor states rifle is new in box.
Condition rating should read: NB.

LOT 696 - Estimate should read: 300 - 500.

LOT 778 - Gun 'A' headline should read: **C.S. Shattuck American Single Shot Shotgun** Description should read: The top of the barrel at the breech is marked "AMERICAN". It has a double trigger mechanism with the front one unlatching the tip down barrel and the rear one for firing. LOP: 13 1/4".
Condition should read: OF NPRF.

LOT 800 - Features a custom walnut stock with leather sling and what appears to be the original 25 1/2" factory barrel that was replaced due to fire damage. An email provided from Earl's Repair Service Inc. indicates that in over 50 years of dealing with Walther products, only two rifles outfitted with a five round magazine have been seen. Estimate should read: 400 - 800.

LOT 848 - Barrel length should read: 6 inch solid rib. Manufactured in 1980. With factory box, manual, two cleaning rods, brushes, and a wood display case. Case interior is disintegrating.

LOT 967 - Headline should read: **Five .22 Caliber Rifles**

LOT 974 - Gun 'B' headline should read: **Remington Fieldmaster Model 572 Lightweight Rifle**
Finish should read: buckskin tan. Stock should read: hardwood. Condition rating should read: NC

LOT 997 - Headline should read: **Beretta Model 92F Semi-Automatic Pistol with Case**. Barrel length should read: 4 7/8 inch round.

LOT 1018 - Gun 'A' serial number should read: D4090.
