### CORRECTIONS

LOT 2 - With presentation case, manual, and factory letter. According to the letter, this Custom Shop pistol left the factory on December 10, 1980, and was shipped to Howco Distributors of Laurel, Maryland. One of 200 Ace pistols made to commemorate the 1980 Moscow Olympics. Case key absent.

LOT 7 - Rating: NE NPRF WW. A small portion of the frame (behind the rear sight) has been cut out.

LOT 24 - Headline: **Walther P5 Compact Semi-Automatic Pistol with Case**. With matching factory case, papers, extra magazine, and rod.

LOT 27 - With matching case, papers, holster, magazine loading tool, extra magazine and a wooden pistol stand with a small plaque marked "AIMCO/STOEGER 6"/SS LUGER (UNDATED)/FINAL PRODUCTION TYPE 5".

LOT 29 - "1991" date marked over the chamber. With matching factory box, copy of the manual, additional papers, tool, extra magazine and a wooden pistol stand with a small plaque marked "MITCHELL/AIMCO/1991 SS

LOT 30 - With generic hard case, papers and a wooden pistol stand with small plaque marked "AIMCO 4" BARREL/BLACK COATED S.S./TYPE 4 (UNDATED)". Consignor states pistol is a preproduction prototype acquired from the owner of AimCo.

LOT 33 - Gun A: With matching factory box, factory case, papers, lock, cleaning tools, magazine loading tool, extra magazine and a metal pistol stand with a blank plaque. Gun B: With matching factory box, factory case, papers, extra magazine and a metal pistol stand with small plaque marked "CZ 75B/FACTORY/CUT-AWAY". Case foam is disintegrating.

LOT 80 - Caliber: 44 Remington magnum. Chambered in .44 Remington magnum/.44 special.

LOT 84 - Headline: **Engraved Winchester Model 1894 Grade I Limited Edition Centennial Lever Action Rifle with Box**. Rating: NB. Estimate: 1000 - 1600.

LOT 115 - Headline: **Browning Citori 525 Grade 3 Over/Under Shotgun with Box**. Gauge: 12.

LOT 177 - Headline: **Belgian Browning High-Power Semi-Automatic Pistol with Tangent Sight**. Backstrap cut for shoulder stock. Estimate: 1400 - 2000.

LOT 182 - Headline: Engraved Colt Pocket Positive Double Action Revolver. Manufactured in 1912. Left sideplate screw protrudes the frame causing cylinder to not rotate freely when open. Bore Condition: Good - Some light pitting or frosted appearance. Rating: OF.

LOT 292 - Sword 1: "SS" marking on both the guard and scabbard throat.

LOT 312 - Headline: **Colt Mexican Contract Model LE6920M001 M4 Law Enforcement Semi-Automatic Carbine with Box**. With matching factory box, manual, sling, cleaning tools, and an extra magazine. Rating: NB. Estimate: 1400 - 2250.

LOT 313 - Headline: **Colt Mexican Contract Model LE6920MP-BM M4 Semi-Automatic Carbine with Box**. With matching factory box, manual, sling, lock, cleaning tools, and an extra magazine. Estimate: 1400 - 2250.

LOT 363 - Headline: **Smith & Wesson M&P9 Shield Pistol with Box**.

LOT 417 - Headline: **Colt Third Generation New Frontier Single Action Army Revolver**. Manufactured after 1978.

LOT 422 - Headline: **Smith & Wesson Model 25-2 Double Action Revolver with Case**. One of an estimated 1,000 with barrels that were incorrectly marked "45 CAL. Model 1950" as opposed to the correct designation of Model 1955. Includes a hardwood case, papers, and cleaning tools.

LOT 431 - Rating: NB PRF WW. Estimate: 1000 - 1500.

LOT 432 - With matching factory box, papers, cleaning rod with brush, and factory letter. The letter indicates the revolver was shipped from the factory on February 12, 1968 to Tower Hardware Co. of Jacksonville, FL. Revolver experiences lock up and timing issues on one chamber. One chamber is a bit loose at full cock.

LOT 481 - Both guns A & B are C&R.

LOT 483 - Both guns A & B are C&R.

LOT 486 - With factory leatherette case, papers, and a plastic pistol stand with small plaque marked "ERMA LUGER/CARBINE". NOTE: Item may not be sold or transferred to individuals in Illinois, Minnesota or Hawaii.

LOT 488 - With generic hard case, papers, tool, extra magazine and a wooden pistol stand with small plaque marked "AIMCO 6" BARREL/SS LUGER(UNDATED)/TYPE 4". Consignor states pistol is a preproduction prototype acquired from the owner of AimCo.

LOT 489 - With matching hard case, papers, extra magazine and a wooden pistol stand with small plaque marked "AIMCO/STOEGER 6"/SS LUGER (UNDATED)/FINAL PRODUCTION TYPE 5".

LOT 490 - "1992" date marked over the chamber. With matching factory box, papers, extra set of grips, extra magazine, and a wooden pistol stand with small plaque marked "MITCHELL/AIMCO/SS LUGER (1992)/TYPE 2".

LOT 492 - "1993" date marked over the chamber. With matching factory box, papers, extra magazine and a wooden pistol stand with small plaque marked "MITCHELL/SPM /SS LUGER (1993)/TYPE 3".

LOT 493 - With copy of a Mitchell Arms American Eagle P-08 manual, additional paperwork, and a wooden pistol stand with a small plaque marked "SPM/SS LUGER (1993)/TYPE 2-1".

LOT 588 - Synthetic stock has been cut down.

LOT 599 - Headline: **Colt Mexican Contract Model LE6920M Law Enforcement Semi-Automatic Carbine with Box**. With matching factory box, manual, sling, cleaning tools, and an extra magazine. Estimate: 1400 - 2250.

LOT 831 - With factory box hand numbered to match and partial (cut down)" picture sleeve.

LOT 850 - Headline: **Smith & Wesson Model 686-6 "Plus" Double Action Revolver with Case**. Features a 7-shot fluted cylinder. With matching factory case, papers, lock, action keys, and 2 speed loaders.
